Aid/Emergency procedures.	Take care and heed safety signs and notes, when on the farm.

9. Spread of contagious	No Smoking in Yurts, Huts or The Yurtery and meeting rooms.
diseases.	Observe social distancing and mask wearing rules, if required by government regulation.

	 Ensure that decking is regularly checked for cleanliness, to minimise the risk of slips and trips.
	 Annually check electricity installations and assess trees on site, for safety.
	Weekly check fire alarms and CO monitors are working.
	Provide adequate first aid facilities and display emergency
