<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fire. 2. Burns from touching hot stoves or ash in firepits. Children at particular risk. 3. Slips and trips, particularly on decking and hammocks. 4. Farming Hazards 5. On site traffic could harm someone. Particularly children. 6. Weather 7. Inadequate First Aid/Emergency procedures. 8. Overhead cables crossing the yurt village. 9. Spread of contagious diseases. 	<p>Customers must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read the site safety notes before or on arrival (provided by email, on website & in hard copies). • Never leave fires or stoves unattended and never use instant BBQ's inside. • At the yurts - Be careful about hot surfaces on the front of the fire and never put anything on top of the wood burners. • Never leave children in the yurts or huts, on their own. • Take particular care, when walking on the decking in the wet (heed signs). • Do not let children run around the site or use the hammocks unsupervised. • Take care and heed safety signs and notes, when on the farm. • Never fly kites underneath overhead power cables. • No Smoking in Yurts, Huts or The Yurtery and meeting rooms. • Observe social distancing and mask wearing rules, if required by government regulation. <p>Meon Springs will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure all fires in the yurts are guarded on three sides. • Ensure that decking is regularly checked for cleanliness, to minimise the risk of slips and trips. • Annually check electricity installations and assess trees on site, for safety. • Weekly check fire alarms and CO monitors are working. • Provide adequate first aid facilities and display emergency procedures on site.
